Trail Maintenance at Olympic National Park

Total In-Kind Value in 2013 in excess of \$50,000

- BCH Washington members contributed approximately 1,300 hours of volunteer-related labor at Olympic National Park in 2013 maintaining trails for hikers and horsemen.
- Their volunteer labor represented an in-kind value of at least \$33,891 (half estimated at the unskilled vol. labor rate of \$22.14/hour; half at the skilled volunteer labor rate of \$30.00/hour).
- Adding use of privately-owned vehicles (POVs), BCH Washington volunteers traveled 2,900 miles for projectrelated to efforts at Olympic National Park that represents:
 - @ \$0.90/mile = an <u>in-kind value of \$2,610 for POV</u> plus,
 - 2,200 miles <u>hauling stock</u> @ \$1.10/mile for an <u>in-kind</u> value of \$2,420.
- BCH Washington volunteers also contributed approximately 140 "stock-days" at Olympic National Park in 2013. Stockdays are conservatively calculated at \$100/day, or <u>in-kind</u> <u>services using stock worth \$14,000</u>.
- The above items reflect a value of at least \$52,921 for total in-kind contribution of labor, POV and stock- days by BCH Washington volunteers in 2013 alone.
