

ENDANGERED SPECIES

Back Country Horsemen of America opposed unjustified regulations or restrictions on back country recreational use due to wolf re-introduction or bear management policies developed by resource management agencies.

May 1994

Passed that: Back Country Horsemen of America supports new legislation and other government actions that will bring greater consideration for people into the Endangered Species Act, especially consideration of economic well being and recreational opportunities

1995

Passed by the NBD that state BCH organizations submit their ESA resolution and position statements for compilation and distribution to directors and appropriate national legislators and agencies as well as the BCHA newsletter.
