BE IT RESOLVED

That the Back Country Horsemen of America (BCHA) hereby urges the various land management agencies to discontinue any further expansion of the privatization concept until a thorough evaluation is made of other more acceptable alternatives for solving the overall funding situation. It is also recommended that each agency should take a hard look at the potential long range consequences of the present management direction. Such an evaluation should include the opportunity for public input in order to obtain the support of a majority of the public land users. Also, be it further resolved that BCHA urges Congress to authorize federal land management agencies, i.e. the Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management and National Park Service to retain the fees collected from recreation use to be spent on-site for administration and maintenance of recreation facilities and services.
